Re: 30 Harrison Street –work on new homes to start end of September

I'm pleased to inform you that work to build these nine new family homes will start towards the end of September.

This work will commence with the arrival on site of additional safety fencing, set-out and a site shed. Then, from Monday 4th October, earthworks will begin on site to prepare the homes' foundations.

Duration of works

The entire project is estimated to take 12 months. This includes the work on the road end improvements to Harrison Street.

These road improvements will be carried out towards the conclusion of the site works.

Working hours

We will be carrying out work on site Monday to Friday, 7.30am to 6pm. To keep on schedule we may look to carry out some work on Saturday's between the same hours.

During the week workers may be on site from 6.30am quietly preparing for work.

Traffic management

We have included a restriction on any heavy vehicles going to or from site during school pick up and drop off times of 8:00-9:30am and 2:00-4:00pm.
