Works on Bond Street are continuing with the final areas of paving going down over the next few weeks.

Catenary lights will be installed this month!

You can still get to the Lombard car parking building and surrounding businesses though diversions might be in place.

→ What to expect over the coming weeks

- Beginning Saturday 7th July, two-way vehicle traffic will be in operation from Victoria Street for most of Bond Street.
- They'll be some diversions in place for Cornhill and Wakefield residents, and people exiting the carpark building.
- Pedestrian diversions to Lombard St businesses will be in place while the overhead catenary lighting is installed. Installation of the new lighting is estimated to take two working days (refer plan overleaf).
- The catenary lighting is designed to improve the night time ambiance and safety of the laneway and is an integral component of the design.
- You will still be able to access all your favourite businesses on Lombard St by following the way finding signage.
