Lombard Street is now closed until the completion of Stage 1. Access to the Lombard car parking building and surrounding local businesses will be maintained.

Some work is weather dependent, which means if it is really wet, we may sometimes have to alter what we do and when.

→ What to expect over the coming weeks

- Trenching works for the sewer and stormwater upgrades will be completed and the new utility lines will be installed. This is being co-ordinated with the upgrade of the underground power utilities to future proof this part of town.
- Foundations for the new furniture in Denton Park will begin to be excavated. Excavation work can be noisy and dirty at times, we're working to keep any disruption to a minimum
- Two street lights in Denton Park have been disconnected and will be removed to make way for construction works. The Bond Street light poles will provide some light in the meantime. The installation of new lighting is estimated to take place in September.
