



Mason's Lane Upgrade

Construction is about to get underway on the makeover of Mason's Lane.

The laneway upgrade is due to start on September 14th 2015 and is expected to take approximately 12 weeks.

Underway at the same time is the Civic Assurance project removing the canopy covering the lane. This is also due to start on September 14th and expected to take approximately 6 weeks.

→ The works

Masons Lane needs some love! Work will be undertaken to transform this important pedestrian link between Lambton Quay and The Terrace to a well-lit and appealing pathway.

The planned work includes an intensive deep-clean of the laneway, installation of a living green wall and timber cladding to walls, painting, paving, lighting and drainage work.

The first stage of this project will be works to the stairwell.

→ Safety and access

Some jobs within the stairwell are wet, dusty or require our construction team to work at height. This means we have to restrict access to the stairwell until these works are complete.

This is safer for the public, work crews and surrounding properties, but it does mean you'll need to use either Farmers Lane or Bowen Street to move between the Terrace and Lambton Quay. We apologise for any inconvenience that this change may have caused.
