### **City Housing Flats: 36-44 & 48-64 Nairn Street**

I'm writing to update you following my 13 September letter and let you know that starting next week we will begin demolition of these earthquake-prone flats.

#### **What's happening**

From Monday 30 September our contractor Naylor Love will start putting up fencing to keep people safe and away from the work site, as they prepare it for demolition work.

Work will be done Monday to Friday between 7.30am and 5pm, with occasional Saturday work. The work is expected to be completed before Christmas.

Our experienced contractor will work to reduce disturbances to residents from dust and noise, but some should be expected given the nature of this work.

#### **Your safety**

The work site will be fenced off for your safety. During working hours a 30km/h speed limit will be in place around the site, and the footpath will be closed.

#### **Next steps**

Council is currently looking at redevelopment options for the site which would see new, more modern social housing properties here. We will update you on this as work progresses.
