Please note we are only accepting two performance groups from each island nation so please make sure your application explains your performance well.

- Perform for **10 minutes or less** (no longer)

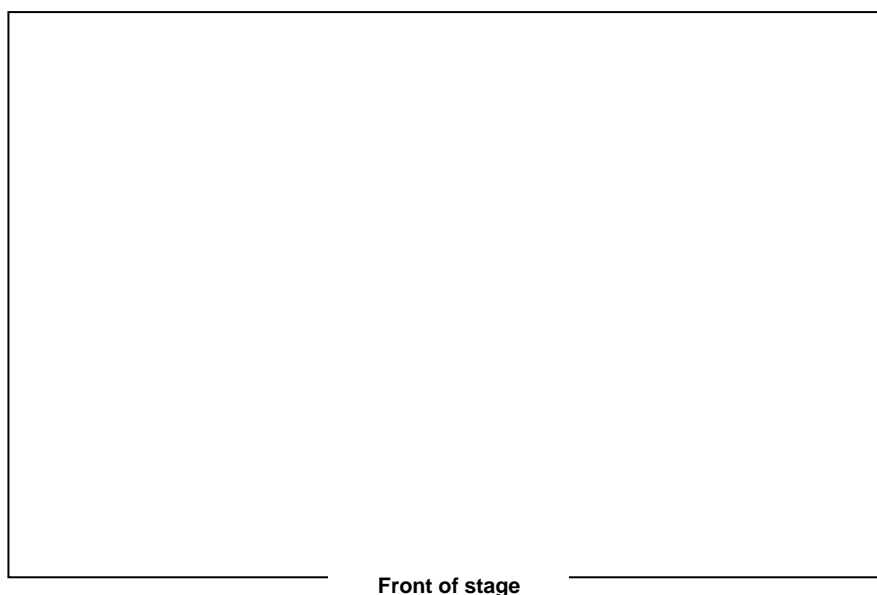
