

Parking for visitors to Johnsonville's Waitohi Community Hub facilities

We are looking at ways to provide additional short stay car parks for visitors to the new Waitohi Community Hub facilities in Moorefield Road, Johnsonville. Before the Council makes any final decisions, we invite your feedback on two possible options. The feedback will be considered in the final recommendation to Council.

About the options

Options 1 and 2 are both within walking distance of the community hub facilities. Both options will provide a mix of P120 and P180 restrictions (105 spaces), drop-off and pick-up (11 spaces), mobility parking (six spaces) and one servicing space.

The main difference between Option 1 and Option 2 is the distance that users of the Community facilities will need to walk from the car parks (shown in the following aerial maps). We also propose other changes to parking bays around the Waitohi Community Hub, which are featured in both options (numbered 1-7 on the aerial maps).

Closing date

Submissions are open from 10 September to 8 October at 5pm.

In terms of the wider parking issues, pressures and opportunities relating to parking in the city centre and town centres, Council is currently reviewing its parking policies and will later this year be seeking your views.

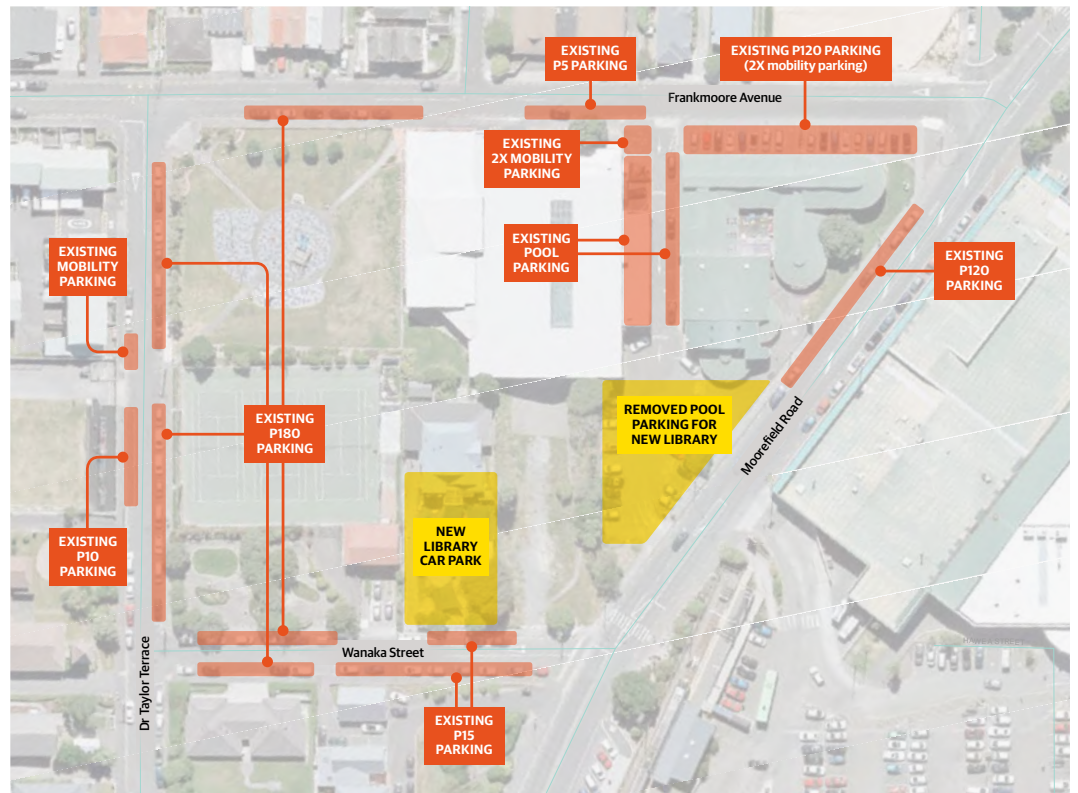
All submissions (including names and contact details) are provided in their entirety to Council officers for the purpose of analysing and feedback. No contact details will be made public or linked to your submission.

Option 1 ▶

This option provides additional P180 parking in Dr Taylor Terrace down to St Peter and Paul's church. These short stay parking bays are further away from the community facilities. This option will change unrestricted parking spaces, often used by commuters to provide short stay spaces for Waitohi Hub users.

Both options also include:

1. Changing the existing parking bays beside Keith Spry pool to P120 from no time limit parking
2. Changing the existing parking bays beside the Community Centre to dedicated parking for volunteers and staff
3. A new library car park with 26 parking bays (22 P120, 3 mobility, 1 service)
4. Moving the mobility parking bays from Wanaka Street and beside Keith Spry pool to the new library carpark
5. Extending the time limit to P180 from P15 on the South side of Wanaka Street
6. Changing the parking bays by the new library on Wanaka Street to P15 for drop-offs and pick-ups.
7. Changing the P5 parking bays on Frankmoore Ave outside Keith Spry Pool to a bus stop for school trips to the pool. Outside this activity the parking bays will be P120.

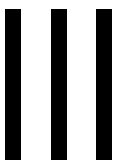
