Decisions will be made publicly available.

The Council is required to report statistics about applications to the Alcohol Regulatory and Licensing Authority. Any member of the public may request access to this information under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987. This information may also be used under the Privacy Act 1993.
