

Wellington Botanic Garden

One of New Zealand's oldest and most beautiful gardens is right in the heart of the capital. Wellington Botanic Garden is the most romantic and picture-perfect outdoor venue for your ceremony.

There are many settings to choose from. These are:

- The Begonia House one of Wellington's most spectacular wedding venues (available from 5pm)
- The Lady Norwood Rose Garden get married among thousands of fragrant blooms
- The Peace Garden a magical setting next to a waterfall
- The Dell our largest lawn, surrounded by lush bush and trees
- The Duck Pond an intimate area with great photographic potential
- Puriri and Linden lawns smaller lawns around beautiful trees near the Duck Pond
- The Soundshell lawn –
 a big lawn banked with blooms
 year-round
- Remembrance Ridge a secluded tree-bordered setting

Otari-Wilton's Bush

Tucked away behind the green hills of the Wellington Town Belt, Otari Wilton's Bush is a unique haven of native trees, flowers and birds.

The Cockayne Lawn is available for ceremonies involving up to 100 people. Imagine your ceremony surrounded by a chorus of birdsong and native New Zealand forest.



Some things to think about when planning your ceremony:

- We strongly advise that you visit our gardens before choosing and booking a space.
- Consider the size of the gathering and the accessibility needs of your guests.
- Make an alternative arrangement just in case the weather is bad.
- You can have your wedding photos taken in the gardens, but you'll have to let us know first – there are often other special events taking place in the gardens on the same day.
- We do not provide furniture. If you want to bring along tables or seating, please discuss this when you book.
- Car parking is available at Otari Wilton's-Bush and the Lady Norwood Rose Garden.
 It is non-reservable. There's also street parking by the Botanic Garden on Glenmore Street. Vehicles are not allowed in any of the gardens.
