It is important to me that the precinct speak to its surroundings and, where beneficial, to the architectural history and historic use of the sites, but I also believe that the buildings should create a new history too. The design proposal, in my view, achieves this.

The landscaping design by Isthmus is very impressive. I would like to see greater planting introduced into the Kumutoto precinct, and believe that two stories that could be better told through the landscaping are: 1. 'Pipitea'. The name of this area refers to the pipis that were said to be translucent, including the shell when held between the eye and the sun. These shell beds were destroyed with the reclamation of the area. Given the importance of this name in our city and to mana whenua -- Taranaki Whanui ki te Upoko o te Ika a Maui -- I believe that this should provide sufficient inspiration to a design team as talented as Isthmus to express it through the landscape. 2. Flax. The area between the Kumutoto and Waipiro streams where this precinct will sit had a large flax base that was used to supply iwi with fibres to create essential products including clothes and kete. While I appreciate the undulating timber platform that speaks to the reclamation history of the area, I think this feature would benefit from greater planting.



Unfortunately, there is very little concrete information in the promotional brochure for the proposal, and so my comments are limited. I note the proposal will be publicly notified later on, if the Council decides to go ahead with it.

I live in Mt Victoria on a section of only 0.15 hectares and so I am very dependent on public open spaces such as the Town Belt and waterfront to enjoy living in Wellington. For a long time the citizens of Wellington have had to fight to keep the waterfront as public open space, with some successes such as at Chaffers Park. I am dismayed to see the Council continuing to insist on building more large buildings on the waterfront space. The Council's growth plans for the city suggest increasing population in the central city which puts an even higher premium on the limited public space left.

There appears to be little good reason for yet another bulky private building on the waterfront, and so I oppose the proposal. My main reasons for opposing it are:

- No reasons are given for why it is necessary, except that the Council planned to have a building there. The building could be anywhere in Wellington as it has no good maritime reason for being on the waterfront.
- There is no evidence that this area of Wellington needs even more new cafes, restaurants, shops and galleries, especially when the horsefloat building is completed at Site 10. I am concerned ratepayers' resources will be wasted on another white elephant such as the Queen's Wharf retail area became.
- If there are any historical maritime cues from its neighbours in its design, they are invisible, unless the resemblance to a stack of containers in front of an iceberg is what the proposal means. The design is completely unsympathetic with the historic Sheds 11 and 13 to the south and the old ferry terminal nearby.
- From the drawings it appears similar in height to the horsefloat building at Site 10, and so may also exceed the Environment Court's height limits for the area. The Council should abide by its own rules.
- Despite the assertion it is "generally in scale with neighbouring premises", this is incorrect in the
 case of its maritime neighbours, Sheds 11 and 13, the iron gates, and the old ferry terminal. It is
 much higher and bulkier than they are. The reference point should not be the office blocks of the
 CBD
- We are told more than half of the ground-floor space would be "publicly accessible" with cafes, restaurants, shops etc. but as these are private businesses, they do not constitute public spaces.

My client, Customhouse Ventures Limited, owns Maritime Tower, a commercial property at 10 Customhouse Quay. We have serious concerns about the proposed development of Site 9 Kumutoto and therefore welcome the chance to provide a submission. We oppose certain aspects of the proposal and these are outlined below: District Plan and council objectives The proposed building goes against the Wellington City Council's District Plan and its objectives for the site, affecting views and heritage values in the area. It will intrude into view shafts prescribed by the District Plan. The proposed building is out of proportion and will dramatically overshadow the neighbouring historic Shed 13, damaging our city's important heritage values. It breaches height determinations set by the Environment Court The proposed development by Willis Bond is higher than the maximum height set down by the Environment Court for Site 9. The Court determined that the northern half of Site 9 should have a maximum height of 19 metres (above mean sea level) and the southern half of the site should be no higher than 16 metres (above mean sea level). The determination's intention is clear - these are 'maximum' heights, so any roof top plant and structures should fall within those heights. The proposed building significantly exceeds those heights, particularly at the southern end, and the rooftop plant extends even further above the prescribed maximum heights. Impact on public amenity We are concerned that the building will reduce public enjoyment of the area in several ways. Firstly, with the intrusion into view shafts as already noted, Wellingtonians will lose the unimpeded harbour views they value so much and which the District Plan has committed to preserve for perpetuity. Secondly, Wellington's 'city-to-sea' values will be reduced with the visual barrier created by this large building, isolating this important area from the CBD. Decrease in the value of neighbouring properties With the extra height above permitted values, the completed building would block waterfront views from Maritime Tower, as well as some other key office buildings nearby. The detrimental effect on the outlook from these commercial properties will in turn reduce their value. This is an unacceptable and unfair outcome. Conclusion I hope that you will reconsider the current design in the light of the above comments.

The Trust's concerns include: The Effect on the Public The building will effectively dislocate the heart of the city from the waterfront by creating an imposing visual barrier. We expect the proposed building will intrude into the view shafts (in breach of the District Plan), negatively affecting the protected views of the iconic Wellington harbour. We are also concerned the proposed building will shade the surrounding area, diminishing the amenity value of the waterfront for Wellingtonians, 162

including Kumutoto Plaza. Impact on Shed 13 We are concerned the height and scale of the proposed building will be overbearing in its relationship to Shed 13, a valuable heritage building which should remain as the centrepiece for the waterfront area. Height contradicts decisions by the Environment Court The height of the proposed development appears to exceed the permitted guidelines stipulated by the Environment Court. The Environment Court was explicit in stating that the maximum height of any building, including rooftop plant and structures, should be 19 metres above mean sea level for the northern half of the site and 16 metres above mean sea level to the south. In terms of height above ground level we consider the building will exceed the maximum height permitted by the Environment Court for the southern half of the site by almost 40% (or almost 80% for the rooftop plant).

HERITAGE NEW ZEALAND POUHERE TAONGA SUBMISSION ON THE DEVELOPMENT PROPOSAL FOR SITE 9

Introduction

- Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga (Heritage New Zealand) is an autonomous Crown Entity
 with statutory responsibility under the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Act 2014 (HNZPTA)
 for the identification, protection, preservation and conservation of New Zealand's historical and
 cultural heritage.
- 2. Heritage New Zealand has been extensively involved in the variety of proposals for the North Kumutoto area. This includes Variation 11, the formation of the North Kumutoto Design Brief, and the resource consents for Site 8 and Site 10. Considering this history of involvement, and Heritage New Zealand's position as New Zealand's lead heritage agency, Heritage New Zealand is somewhat surprised that we have not been consulted earlier in this development process.

Heritage value

- 3. North Kumutoto is an area rich in nationally significant historic heritage. Of particular importance to the proposed development is the nearby Shed 13. This building is a Category 1 Historic Place, which means it is of special or outstanding historic heritage significance or value. Built in 1905, the simple and elegant Shed 13 has played an integral part in Wellington's trading and commercial history. It remains an important part of the City's waterfront.
- 4. Site 9 is also within the proposed Wellington Harbour Board Historic Area, which is currently considered for entry onto the New Zealand Heritage List / Rārangi Kōrero. This area encompasses much of the Wellington waterfront. It recognises that the important heritage of this area forms a collective whole, and that its value is more than the sum of the individual heritage buildings and structures.
- 5. Heritage New Zealand also notes that there is the potential for archaeological material to be discovered in any earthworks. Accordingly, the Council should undertake an archaeological assessment and, if necessary, apply for an authority under the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere and accordingly.

Potential impacts on heritage

 Given the heritage significance of the area, Heritage New Zealand considers it imperative that any development is appropriately designed to avoid, remedy, or mitigate its adverse effects on historic heritage value.

- 7. The information provided does not contain sufficient detail for Heritage New Zealand to be confident that the interface between the proposed building and Shed 13 will be sympathetic to historic heritage. It also does not provide details on how the proposal may affect key site lines to Shed 13, nor how it would relate to the proposed Historic Area.
- 8. Based on the limited information available to us, Heritage New Zealand is concerned about how the height and bulk of the proposed building may adversely affect Shed 13 and the surrounding historic environment. In particular, we note that the building height does not comply with that set in the North Kumutoto Design Brief. This Wellington City Council (Council) document sets a maximum height limit of 19m at the northern end of the building and 16m at the southern end (including roof top structures).
- 9. This height limit is based upon that established in the Environment Court appeal on Variation 11, with the intention being that it creates a stepping down in height to the lower Shed 13. The decision of the Environment Court reflects a considered approach designed to ensure development is in proportion to the surrounding historic environment and that it meets the principles in the Wellington Waterfront Framework. This framework states that new buildings in the North Queens Wharf Area will be in proportion to the heritage buildings, including Shed 13. Heritage New Zealand cannot see any rationale provided by the Council to justify heights over and above that established through the robust process already completed.

Conclusion

- 10. While Heritage New Zealand does not oppose building on site 9, we are very concerned that the Council has disregarded the considerable work done on determining appropriate height limits in the North Kumutoto. These limits respect historic heritage value and are included in Council's own documents. The proposal documents also do not provide sufficient detail to determine the extent of other adverse effects. In the absence of this information, Heritage New Zealand reserves its position on the proposed design, as it cannot be confident that the proposal will respect and promote the heritage value of one of Wellington's most important areas.
- 11. To address this, Heritage New Zealand wishes to meet with the Council to discuss the proposal prior to public notification and to have more detailed plans made available. The Council is also encouraged to contact the Regional Archaeologist, Kathryn Hurren, to discuss compliance with the archaeological authority process under the Heritage New Zealand Pouhere Taonga Act 2014. Introduction

The Wellington City Youth Council welcomes the opportunity to submit on the Site 9 Proposal. We have in the past supported the development of North Kumutoto, particularly open space on Site 8.

The Proposal

Young people around Wellington are passionate about the incredible social amenity the Wellington Waterfront brings to the city. The developments already completed on North Kumutoto, and those both underway and planned, will add significant value to the surrounding area. We note the Environment Court decision limiting building heights and footprints in 2011, and support the positioning of the building on Site 9 that preserves the view shafts from the CBD to the water, in line with the Environment Court decision.

The Youth Council encourages Council to ensure possibilities for retail, food and beverage, and complementary outlets are located on the ground floor of the Site 9 building, providing services amenable to the public space situated alongside at Site 8 and the general waterfront walkway, given the close proximity.

We acknowledge that within an urban Central Business District (CBD), open space should be used effectively, and that this at times means building development. Of paramount importance in deciding on the form the development on Site 9 should take is that the public amenity value of the Waterfront must not only be retained, but enhanced to preserve public access, alongside providing both an enjoyable and functional multi-purpose public space.

The Youth Council acknowledges works both planned and underway to enhance the public space on North Kumutoto Site 8, and stress our support of designs for Site 9 that ensure linkages to this public space, allowing for a shared space for various activities. Central to this is the need to ensure adequate cross-planning between Site areas, to ensure all Sites are 'tied together' and present a united feel conducive to public use, rather than be conceptualised in isolation. We note the Council's continuing work on this aspect of North Kumutoto.

We would note our concern that this building may contribute to channelling wind in the direction of Waterloo and Customhouse Quay at street level. We would ask that due consideration of the potential impact of this be considered, as the effects of such wind movements would dissuade pedestrians from using this area.

Noting the clear value of walkable transport paths in Wellington, especially those paths around the Waterfront, we would also ask that Council make a clear commitment to improving connection nodes linking to North Kumutoto, notably the pedestrian crossing that feeds onto the Waterfront in this area, nearest the NZ Post building. We note that this was identified as "critical to the success of the waterfront development" in the 2001 Wellington Waterfront Framework. Further, we encourage Council to ensure improved lighting is considered within the planning for this area, noting that at current this area is poorly lit at night, and is used extensively by many sports fans going to and from Westpac Stadium. Improved lighting would allow for better use of the space and increase safety given its location next to the Wellington Harbour.

Summary

Overall, the Youth Council are supportive of the proposed development on North Kumutoto Site 9, noting our express desire to ensure and enhance public access is considered and incorporated throughout the development.

Submission on Proposed Development for Site 9, Wellington Waterfront

Thank you for the opportunity to make a submission on the proposed development of Site 9 on the Wellington Waterfront.

Cornerstone Partners is a Wellington-based commercial property investment company owning various buildings through single asset owning companies. We own the building at 36 Customhouse Quay through our company 36 Customhouse Quay Limited and have some concerns about the proposed development on Site 9.

Although Cornerstone Partners does not object in principle to the proposed development of this high-value vacant site, we have concerns over aspects of the design and apparent height of this building.

1.Environment Court Decisions:

The design of this proposed building, as it currently stands, means it exceeds the maximum heights specified by the Environment Court. As we understand it, for Site 9, the Northern half of the site should have a maximum height of 19 metres above mean sea level and the Southern half of the site should be no higher than 16 metres above mean sea level.

The Environment Court was clear in its determination that any rooftop plant and associated structures should not exceed these maximum heights.

We are concerned that it appears to us that the proposed building will be significantly higher than that permitted by the Environment Court and that the plant room essentially adds another floor on top in its effect on view. This will

impact on the views our tenants enjoy from the lower floors of the building at 36 Customhouse Quay.

2. The Proposal & the City's District Plan:

In our view, the proposed building is contrary to the Wellington City Council's own District Plan in that the proposed building does not comply with the view shafts to the North and South of site 9.

In addition, Shed 13 is an important heritage building and we are concerned that the height of the proposed development will overpower this landmark.

3. The Impact on Value of 36 Customhouse Quay:

The non-complying aspects of the proposed building on site 9 will impact our tenants' views from the lower floors in our building which will have an effect on the property's value.

With the proposed building, once completed, exceeding permitted maximum heights for this site it will block views for our property and other buildings nearby.

4.Conclusion:

The height of this proposed building, the impact on important view shafts, and its effect on the value of our property is unacceptable.

There was one respondent who was neutral/ambivalent as the design of the area and building neither excited or worried them, and they were not really affected as they don't use that area of the waterfront much.

Five respondents, who had selected oppose/strongly oppose also commented, selecting: my feedback won't change the result; that creating a canyon of buildings will suppress the feeling of wide open space that exists in this part of the waterfront and which people enjoy.

Q3. Overall, what is the level of support for the design of the proposed building at Site 9?

Eleven of the 18 respondents who supported/strongly supported the proposal selected the option 'liked the design of the building'.

Q4. What improvements of changes would you suggest for the design of the building?

22 out of the 28 respondents answered this question and could select multiple options. Six respondents selected 'nothing needs to change'.

In response to our question of how the design of the area be improved, three respondents selected reduce the height of the building (2) and change the design of the building (1). One respondent also commented 'more food caravans, not food courts. More sculptures and art, less building. People come here to get away from office blocks and enjoy a different dynamic'.

Other improvement suggestions were:

Traffic:

- Restrict vehicle access to service vehicles and taxis and make it one way (9), with one
 respondent also stating that restricting vehicle access would be good, but not for bikes.
- Require cars entering the underground carpark to use the entrance opposite Brandon St (10)
- Mixed vehicle/pedestrian use of Whitmore Plaza limits the flexibility to create sheltered areas for seating in that area from wind and sun (other)

Open space

- Put some of the open area in grass (11)
- Have more trees in Whitmore Plaza (13)
- Have more seating areas in Whitmore Plaza (12)
- Provide some protection from the wind that funnels through the area and cover over the walkways for rainy days so it's more viable to walk along the waterfront from the station to Courtenay/Te Aro/Mt Victoria areas.

Other comments

While the consultation has been purposely limited to the building for the resource consent process, the responses show that ICW members have ideas to improve how the whole area works together. Work has already started on the public space nearest the water (by the Kina sculpture). Hopefully our feedback on how the open spaces interact will still be considered given the early stages of development of the open area.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit on the proposed development of site 9.

I don't see how this building can be viable. The proposal for a building on site 10 was only viable if they exceeded the height limit and had huge site coverage. Using the same argument, there is no way the building on site 9 can be a viable commercial proposition. I also question the need for a new building on the waterfront (public space) when there are several new office blocks being built in close proximity.

I am also pretty sure that a high rise building on this site isn't in accordance with the Waterfront Framework. It will block views and vistas from the city and block the waterfront from anyone who isn't standing by the sea.

In addition to this a building on this site will not be sympathetic/in character to the area "the character of the area will be of squares, lanes and any new buildings in scale with the heritage buildings such as Shed 21 at the northern end and the Queens Wharf apartments and Sheds 11 and 13 at the southern end' as noted on Page 32 of the Framework.

There has been limited opportunity to provide meaningful engagement or consultation with the public and community. Surely it would be possible for City Shaper to directly contact those that have submitted before, regardless of their views, to have a say in further determining

the use of waterfront property or for this site in particular. The environment court has been quite specific previously about meaningful consultation. This doesn't appear to have been applied here again.

The height of this building is not specified so how are submitters able to comment on the building, the information is limited and does not cover off what should be provided to make an informed meaningful decision.

I believe that there should be no building on site 9 and it should be included as public space. There are more and more people living in the central city and recreational space is needed. Leave the waterfront alone.

2. About Newcrest

Newcrest welcomes the opportunity to provide a submission to the Wellington City Council on the proposed development for Site 9 on the Wellington Waterfront.

Newcrest is a New Zealand family-owned company which has been developing award-winning high-quality commercial, residential, industrial and retail properties throughout New Zealand for more than a quarter of a century. Newcrest has had an office in Wellington for most of that period. We specialise in creating attractive, energy efficient buildings that minimise their impact on the environment.

Newcrest is currently managing the development of 20 Customhouse Quay, which is owned by 20 Customhouse Quay LP. Newcrest also manages a property at 1 Whitmore Street, which is owned by Balfour Whitmore Limited and Wilton CQ Limited. We are supportive of a vibrant Wellington waterfront.

3. Opposition to proposed development for Site 9, Wellington Waterfront

Wellington City Council and Willis Bond are proposing a five-level building along Customhouse Quay on Site 9 Kumutoto, a high-profile vacant site on Wellington's waterfront.

Newcrest as an owner and developer of neighbouring properties is not opposed to the development of the site in principle. However, Newcrest is opposed to aspects of the proposal as currently designed for the following reasons:

a. It does not comply with Environment Court determinations

The proposal is for a building with the same number of floors and almost the same height as the Site 10 building currently in construction, which is not what the Environment Court intended.

For Site 9, the Environment Court has stated that the northern half of the site should have a maximum height of 19 metres above mean sea level and the southern half of the site should be no higher than 16 metres above mean sea level. It is clear from the relevant decision that those heights are maximum heights and therefore are intended to include any plant and roof top structures. However, the proposed building exceeds the maximum heights for the site by up to 8.5 metres for the roof top plant and up to 5 metres in other areas. That is unacceptable.

It should also be noted that in 2013 Willis Bond proposed a building structure of 25.7 metres for the neighbouring Site 10 location, despite the Environment Court specifying that the maximum height should be 22 metres. The height was later reduced after negative public reaction. In the case of Site 9, the extent of infringement in the proposed design is more serious.

b. It is contrary to the District Plan

The proposal is contradictory to the Wellington City Council's own District Plan and the Council's own previously stated objectives for the site. The proposed building would intrude into two of the view shafts prescribed by the District Plan.

c. It would detract from Wellington's heritage

The lack of the required step down to 16m from near the mid-point of the site means that the new building would overwhelm and dominate the neighbouring historic Shed 13 to the detriment of Wellington's heritage, something that the Environment Court and previous schemes on the site have sought to preserve.

d. It will reduce the value of neighbouring properties

The building, once complete, would obstruct views of the waterfront from properties we own and some other nearby buildings. The extra height above the permitted maximums, together with the view shaft intrusions, would significantly affect nearby properties including the new building at 20 Customhouse Quay, robbing tenants of valuable views of the Wellington waterfront, harbour and landscape beyond. The result would be a substantial loss of value from the neighbouring properties; some of that value would be transferred to Site 9. The owners of the nearby buildings, including the owners we represent, rely on the Council to enforce the provisions of the District Plan and to respect the Environment Court's previous decision on the matter in order to preserve, as far as it would be reasonable to expect, the value of their investments.

e. It will reduce public enjoyment

The proposed building would intrude into view shafts along the Wellington waterfront and rob Wellingtonians of views of their harbour that the District Plan intended to preserve for all time. A building of this scale would provide a significant visual barrier, isolating this important area from the city.

The proposal would also dominate and shade the public open space at Kumutoto, undermining the significant investment in this area for public enjoyment.

4. Conclusion

Newcrest is grateful for the opportunity to outline its submission to the proposed development on Site 9 on the Wellington. Newcrest would welcome the opportunity to present to the Wellington City Council in person.

This submission is from the Architectural Centre, an incorporated society dating from 1946, which represents both professionals and non-professionals interested in the promotion of good design.

We have the following comments to make regarding the development proposal for Site 9 on Wellington Waterfront:

- 1. The Wellington City Council has a **Low Carbon Capital Plan 2016-2018** (LCCP) (October 2016)¹ which is less than a year old. It identifies "building energy use and private transport" as the areas where Wellington city can mostly make a difference today (LCCP p. 9), and asserts that "**if we don't stop creating the problem then our adaptation challenges become even more difficult**" (LCCP p. 12). It also states that currently 38% of Wellington city's emissions are from stationary energy (LCCP p. 17) which includes building energy-use, and positions the council as "Leading by example" (LCCP p. 22).
- 2. We support the council's ambitions in the Low Carbon Capital Plan, but we do not see that it substantially translates into this project for Site 9. The council indeed (rather than just in word) needs to lead by example. Council developments must be Zero Net Carbon (ZNC) if Wellington is going to have a viable low carbon emissions future. By this we mean net zero construction emissions and net zero operating emissions proven by independent life cycle analysis. Including relevant analysis as part of any future resource consent application would assist in demonstrating that the council actually does care about energy-use and reducing our collective emissions. If the Council can't be assertive and progressive in this area then who can? Stating double-glazing and insulation are to be used in a building just doesn't cut it anymore - that's simply meeting very minimum requirements. It is common practice in buildings these days to have insulation and double-glazing. This is not leading by example but being dragged along by the conservative apron strings of the Building Code. ZNC building is defined as "a highly energy efficient building that produces on-site or procures, enough carbon-free renewable energy to meet the building operations energy consumption annually." Architecture 2030, for

- example, has a brief statement outlining this.² This is the standard the Council must achieve to have integrity in relation to Climate Change.
- 3. It's nice that the council is planning to have passive solar power (Site 9 p. 7) but what exactly does this mean? Sunlight through the windows? or sufficient photovoltaics to power the building's energy needs all year long? The detail on this is so vague it is hard not to see this as greenwashing.³ This building is an opportunity to promote a partial green roof, rooftop water collection, grey water recycling, car sharing, electric vehicle charging, bike parking and *not* adding to conventional basement car parking (Site 9 p. 4).
- 4. Your Low Carbon Capital Plan explicitly queries the value of minimum parking requirements (LCCP p. 15). We cannot see a need for CBD buildings to provide car-parking, and note that Astelia Hotel has demonstrated the viability of this. The council needs to promote urban life without car ownership and without car parks which spend most of their life entertaining vacant space. Car-sharing, car-hire and taxis are viable supplements to regular PT use, walking and cycling.
- 5. The high levels of glazing (even when double-glazed) are a cause for concern when there is no plan, because there is no designated function yet. This amount of double-glazing will not ameliorate the sins of glazing in terms of winter heat-loss and summer heat-gain, and could be particularly worrying for residential (apartment and hotel) functions. We strongly recommend the reduction of glazing on the building because of its demands on energy. G7 of the building code (Natural light) needs to be considered to be a maximum (rather than a minimum) for natural light in order to minimise energy-use. The proposal of an exterior without any idea of how the interior will function also undermines any substance to the viability of their being "environmentally sustainable design" (p. 7). It is important to know what is meant by this term: "environmentally sustainable design" in this context. What is the performance of the building in terms of energy and thermal comfort?
- 6. The building is proposed for an environmentally tough site. Wind in particular can be an issue on the waterfront. How is this addressed in the design? How does the design meet the WCC Wind Design Guide? Will it improve the wind environment or not? Information regarding the impact of the building on the microclimate of public spaces around the building (e.g. wind and sun) would be helpful for a proper consultation.
- 7. The building's location on the waterfront, and within an area liable to flooding from sea level rise and/or tsunami, makes this building vulnerable. How does the design anticipate such issues in a resilient manner, and what are the potential liabilities for the Council? We also note that the design should anticipate the completion of the northern section of the harbourfront promenade, and any possible effects this might have on this building and its relationship to context.
- 8. As noted above, the proposed is for a building which currently has no use. Instead it is stated that there will be 4,000 sqm of lettable space (Site 9 p. 4), which may be "high quality commercial office space, serviced

apartments or a boutique hotel" (p. 5). At this point it seems vital to state the obvious: "What are the current needs of the city?" We have been, for most of this year, greeted daily with outcries for more housing, the increasingly the plight of the homeless, and intermittent responses from the Mayor and the Deputy Mayor claiming that addressing housing supply, social housing and affordable housing is top of the council agenda. We have been told that the housing crisis will take years to address and we are playing catchup. Owners of inner city office buildings are encouraged to convert them into housing. The stunningly obvious question to ask is: why are we not addressing issues of housing need in this development?

- 9. We are pleased that it is proposed that the ground floor be publicly accessible well only half of it. But it appears that the focus will be commercial. Is public space really public if you have to buy something in order to justify being there? What space (and how much) will be available for people to use without pressure to spend money?
- 10. In a related matter, the proposal is light on what public facilities will be available. Will there be free wifi? free public toilets and changing sheds? free tourist information? a citizen advice bureau? ... Public access to a commercialised ground floor is not enough. This is a public building. The best bit will be the rooftop. This needs to be accessible to the public too perhaps with some free viewing space, and a small cafe?
- 11. The document states that: "The design for site 9 takes strong cues from its historical maritime context" (p. 7). This is not evident in the design in any way. It just appears to be an average office block be honest about it. It is not particularly adventurous or progressive in design terms; but aesthetically it is sufficient. More important than a faux heritage argument is an understanding of how the building will aesthetically and formally work in relation to the other structures of the waterfront (past, current and future) and its relationship to the CBD.
- 12. We have found that the consultation information is insufficient at a number of levels. The images of the building, for example, are deceptive. Glass seen from the outside of buildings is usually perceived as dark (black or grey) not transparent. This suggests the need for more accurate drawings for any future resource consent process. The text is shallow and needs more detail to support its claims. Saying something is "environmentally friendly" does not automatically achieve this. Give us the data and analysis to show that the building will actually be a positive contribution to the environment. Give us a truely public architecture which the city can be proud of, and one which has integrity aesthetically, environmentally and civicly as a meaningful contribution to public space on the ground floor and on the best viewing platform of the roof. But also give us a building which is really needed in this time of housing shortage. Show us some leadership.

ABOUT THE CHAMBER

The Wellington Chamber of Commerce (the Chamber) has been the voice of business in the Wellington region for 161 years since 1856 and advocates for policies that reflect the interest of Wellington's business community, in both the city and region, and the development of the Wellington economy as a whole. We are also the hub Chamber for the lower North Island, and work with the Taranaki, Hawke's Bay, Dannevirke, Manawatu, Whanganui, Wairarapa, Kapiti, Porirua and Hutt Valley Chambers of Commerce.

The Chamber is accredited through the New Zealand Chamber of Commerce network and as part of our wider organisation is also one of the four regional organisations of BusinessNZ. Our organisation also delivers membership services through Business Central to the Central New Zealand region, and ExportNZ to Central New Zealand.

OVERVIEW

The Chamber welcomes the opportunity to submit on Wellington City Council's Site 9, North Kumutoto consultation. We welcome the wider development of North Kumutoto, bringing improvements to the surrounding public spaces.

The Chamber is very supportive of the general direction of the wider Wellington Waterfront development. The programme of work since 2001 has helped make Wellington an attractive place to work, live and visit and so has enhanced both the local economy and the business environment. We welcome the emphasis on public spaces surrounded by low-rise, mixed-use buildings incorporating residential, commercial, retail and hospitality activities. However we are concerned that this consultation does not include financial implications, and would strongly encourage this information be made available.

SITE 9, NORTH KUMUTOTO

The Chamber supports Wellington Waterfront Framework intent that the waterfront ought to be "... a special place that welcomes all people to live, work and play in beautiful and inspiring spaces and architecture that connect our city to the sea and protect our heritage for future generations." We agree, that the waterfront is a central part of "Wellington's identity, an important visitor attraction, a well known civic place, leisure space and business location."

We would like to take this opportunity to comment on the use of the site 9. Given the need for a five star hotel in Wellington and the prime waterfront location offered by Kumutoto, we think this would be an excellent use of the site. The Chamber is on the record having long-



advocated that the design brief of the wider North Kumutoto area should have accommodated such a hotel and that it be actively pursued as part of this commercial development.

The Chamber is concerned that this may be another missed opportunity, developing another office building on Wellington's waterfront rather than a hotel, particularly in light of Wellington's successful growth as a visitor destination. We would support the option put forward in the proposal that instead of commercial office space, that it be better used for high quality serviced apartments or a boutique hotel.

In this regard, we were also disappointed that the proposal for the Shipwreck museum was also not progressed, given the potential success of this visitor attraction, the generosity of those involved, and locality to other tourist attractions.

We are supportive of the design, and the purported environmental and resilience features. We are also supportive that the space will continue to support visitor, leisure and cultural activities and provide quality shared space. However, without financial details we are unable to comment further, or in any substance, on whether the project will provide a return on investment or be of benefit to the ratepayers, in particular, benefit to the commercial ratepayers of Wellington City who pay 47% of the total rate take, while only making up 21% of rateable property. We would strongly recommend that financial information be included and that this information is made available as soon as possible, to ensure the project can be supported.

I feel the Wellington Waterfront has a significant civic role and destination space for the Wellington region.

I have reviewed the proposed new building at site 9, North Kumutoto, Wellington Waterfront (proposed development) and make the following submission.

Building Height

My assessment shows that the proposed development is likely to exceed the District Plan maximum height limits for the area. The District Plan was designed to protect the nature of the waterfront area and preserve the predominant scale of the existing buildings. The proposed development appears to exceed these limits by at least 1.5 storeys. This is likely to be to the detriment of the surrounding urban landscape and in our opinion is not compatible with the surrounding buildings on this stretch of the Wellington waterfront.

Recommendation: that the building height is restricted to that detailed in the Wellington City District Plan 13.6.3.1.

Waterfront & City connectivity

Our assessment also shows that the proposed development will cut into View Shafts 4 and 5 as allocated by the District Plan (Chapter 13 (13.6.3.3), Appendix 11). These view shafts are essential to the value and permeability of the surrounding area. The view both from the Jervoius Quay, the surrounding buildings and through the open public areas provides a connection to the waterfront and back to the orthogonal grid of the city. I feel that by intruding into these view shafts the proposal unnecessarily restricts that valuable connection between city and sea that the District Plan preserves.

Recommendation: the building envelope needs to be better designed to be more sympathetic to these view shafts and retain the aesthetic of the surrounding area.

Thank you for your consideration. I am available to discuss these concerns and feel these items should be carefully considered in any Resource Consent granted to the development.



Thank you for the opportunity to express our views on the proposal for a new 5 level building on Site 9, North Kumutoto, Wellington Waterfront and we would question the need for more office space as just across the road there are three new office blocks under construction.

We are totally opposed to a high rise building on this site and would refer you to Page 20 of the Waterfront Framework where it states "Important views and vistas from the city to sea will be protected and important new ones created".

What a farce as Page 8 of the North Kumutoto Development proposal for Site 9, it states "the proposed building is generally in scale with neighbouring premises. The views from Customhouse Quay coming from the north, along with the construction on Site 10 will almost block out the Harbour, Eastbourne Ferry Terminal, Oriental Bay and the Mt Victoria St Gerard's Monastry.

On Page 32 of the Framework it states "the character of the area will be of squares, lanes and any new buildings in scale with the heritage buildings such as Shed 21 at the northern end and the Queens Wharf apartments and Sheds 11 and 13 at the southern end.

We would like to quote from a report by Russell Murray, Conservation Architect in 2008 on Heritage values. The old waterfront buildings in the Kumutoto area have high architectural values and interest. The collection is important as a representative group that illustrates the development and use of the historic working waterfront. There are important and long standing views to the area and through to the harbour from the landward side and extended views along the length of the area on the seaward side. The views enable appreciation of the area and its features from many different parts of the waterfront and the city. In summary the Kumutoto area and its wider setting is of high historic significance and has important social, architectural, technical and archaeological values. Sadly with the Meridian, Sheds 11 and 13 are now blocked out from the sea and all that remains is a delivery lane!

In May 1996 Ann Breen and Dick Rigby from the Waterfront Centre, Washington DC made a number of recommendations to a waterfront forum saying that Wellington had reached a critical point in deciding what to do to create a superlative waterfront which included an interior winter garden so people could enjoy the harbour views during the winter, displays on the maritime heritage of the harbour, facilities to house environmental and maritime education programmes and new and expanded play areas.

In 2008 yet another recommendation from Cathy Simon, an American architect on the subject of "are we getting it right" made the point what an asset our waterfront is and should be the major open space and that views from the harbour to the waterfront are also important.

Finally would like to quote from a USA Planning commissioners journal in 2001 – small scale improvements can be more effective as drawing people in to spaces than BIG BUCK projects. Amenities such as vending carts, outdoor café tables/umbrellas and chairs are relatively inexpensive to host a range of events. Plazas and squares in Europe fitting this description have been seen to which the public is drawn.
