1 Fund Criteria and Priorities

(REPORT 1)

Mayor Wallace asked that it be recorded that Hutt City Council is consulting with its community on the Fund through their Annual Plan process and this will also feed into the review of the criteria and priorities.

2 Expressions of Interest in the Wellington Regional Amenities Fund

(REPORT 2)

The Committee noted that the Wellington Free Ambulance provide a valuable and important service for the region but agreed that they were not a fit with the criteria of the Fund. Hutt City and Wellington City Councils noted that they will be looking at funding levels for the Wellington Free Ambulance through their Annual Plan and contract funding processes in 2013.

Moved Mayor Rowan, seconded Mayor Wallace.

That the Committee:

- 1. Receive the information.
- 2. Agree that the following projects should be funded in principle, with the funding released on receipt of an acceptable detailed application and budget.
 - a. The 'Winter of Art' Programme and Art Lovers Tours across the region's galleries - \$215,000
 - b. Visitor experience development working across the region's environmental attractions \$300,000
 - c. The 2014 New Zealand International Arts Festival opening large-scale outdoor event \$300,000
 - d. 2015 first steps The 2014 ANZAC Eve concert in the first year of WW100 - New Zealand Symphony Orchestra -\$50,000
- *3.* Agree the criteria and priorities will be reviewed once Annual Plans are finalised.
- 4. Agree to invite applications from 1 August, 2013 noting existing successful applicants may re-apply.
- 5. Agree to liaise with existing and potential military heritage projects around the region to develop a connected programme for 2015 that will maximise the Wellington region's capacity to attract visitors in that year and beyond.
- 6. Agree to liaise with theatre organisations in the region to explore potential joint approaches, including cooperation to secure Creative New Zealand funding.

The motion was then put to the vote and was **CARRIED.**
