TRAFFIC RESOLUTIONS

1. Purpose of Report

This report outlines the recommended amendments to the Wellington City Council Traffic Restrictions. These recommendations support the achievement of the Council's Transport Strategy Outcomes of safety, accessibility, efficiency and sustainability. All of the proposed traffic restrictions were publicly advertised and there were no unwithdrawn objections.

3. Discussion

The following information relates to the amendments before the Committee for approval.

(a) No Stopping At All Times, Clearway, Metered Parking – Cambridge Terrace – Te Aro (17-09)

As part of the reassessment of parking in Wellington City, two spaces suitable for metered parking have been identified. One, outside the Golf Warehouse, is a simple reinstatement of an approved metered carpark removed by a now redundant vehicle crossing. The other is outside a vehicle sales yard in an area where broken yellow lines are painted. These are both worthwhile additions to the city's parking stock. Metered parking is also being brought in line with the Council's policy to charge for metered parking until 6:00pm on Saturdays.

(b) Resident Parking – Goldies Brae – Thorndon (25-09)

This proposal follows representations from local residents, mostly without offstreet parking, for consideration of residents parking. This proposed extension falls neatly within the existing Thorndon Residents Parking Zone and is supported by the local Councillor. It will provide some much needed and convenient parking in an area within the encompassing Coupon Parking Zone.

(c) Mobility Parking – Park Road – Miramar (42-09)

Mobility parks were requested by the Disability Reference Group (DRG) near the shops along Park Road. These parks will provide mobility users access to the local post shop, library, local chemist, the medical centre and other services in the vicinity. The mobility parking policy aims to ensure Wellington is a liveable place for people with limited mobility by enhancing their ability to participate in social, cultural and political life and their access to services and resources.

(d) No Stopping At All Times – Truscott Avenue – Johnsonville (45-09)

The Council has received a request from the public to mark the intersection of McLintock Street and Truscott Avenue between 47 and 49 as No Stopping At All Times. This will improve the visibility of vehicles turning at this intersection.

(e) Time Restricted Parking, No Stopping At All Times – Burgess Road – Johnsonville (47-09)

Parking was prohibited on both sides of this section of Burgess Road following amalgamation of the Khandallah fire service with Johnsonville, it being the only access to and egress from the Johnsonville Fire Station. The station has now been replaced with a larger, modern structure and emergency vehicles depart directly onto Frank Johnson Street and only return via their access way off Burgess Road.

Retailers in Burgess Road have been requesting short-term parking for some time and now, following re-assessment of access needs for the fire service, it has become possible to consider the business community's requirements.

The proposed P60 should meet retailers' request for short-term parking and relieve them of the isolation since it was deemed necessary to prohibit parking to ensure emergency access at all times.

(f) Time Restricted Parking – Rotherham Terrace – Miramar (59-09)

The Council has received a petition from members of the public requesting for short-stay time restricted parking beside the main entrance of Tuatara Kids - Tuakana on Rotherham Terrace. This parking facility will enable parents to drop-off and pick-up their children safely as most parking on the street are occupied by commuter parking.

(g) Mobility Parking – Normanby Street – Newtown (60-09)

The existing mobility park is currently without time restriction. The low turnover makes it difficult for short-stay mobility users to access this park. A 60-minute time limit is proposed to allow for parking turnover and coincide with the current time restriction in the area.

(h) No Stopping At All Times – Frankmoore Avenue – Johnsonville (61-09)

The Council has received a request from members of the public and the management of the community centre to mark the space outside of 10 Frankmoore Avenue as No Stopping At All Times. There have been several non-injury crashes due to vehicles reversing out from the community centre carpark.

(i) Time Restricted Parking – Hobson Street – Thorndon (64-09)

There was public interest in Council giving consideration of parking spaces near the Hobson Street over bridge for visitors to Katherine Mansfield Memorial Park and Lady McKenzie Park for the Blind on Hobson Street. This proposal will fulfil that need in an area that is currently within the Coupon Parking Zone.

(j) No Stopping At All Times – George Street – Thorndon (65-09)

A site visit resulting from public enquiries revealed some anomalies between the Traffic Resolutions Database, legal requirements and restrictions marked onstreet. The purpose of this report is to make minor amendments and legalise parking restrictions in the database. None of these changes alter the number of on-street car parks.

(k) No Stopping At All Times, P120 Resident Parking – Goring Street – Thorndon (66-09)

A site visit resulting from local enquiries has revealed some anomalies in the database. The purpose of this report is to update the database of traffic and parking restrictions in Wellington.

(l) No Stopping At All Times – Friend Street – Karori (67-09)

Anomalies in the application of broken yellow lines at the intersection of Friend Street and Samuel Parnell Road with Parkvale Road have been brought to our attention by a local resident. This report recommends minor changes to ratify parking restrictions that will enable the intersection to function safely while maximising parking for local residents. The recommended two metre extension of broken yellow line ensures larger vehicles can proceed unimpeded past a median traffic island into Parkvale Road.

(m) No Stopping At All Times, Public Utility Vehicles Parking – Palliser Road – Roseneath (68-09)

An existing small telecommunications junction box, upgrading a larger, existing local electrical substation and proposed resource consent to construct off-street parking opposite has prompted a review of parking restrictions in this area.

To accommodate servicing it is proposed to recommend the provision of an area exclusively for utility service vehicles in place of part of an existing broken yellow line. To ensure reasonable access to through-traffic along this narrow road remains available, it is proposed to simultaneously relocate the existing broken yellow line opposite and this will also ensure that unimpeded access to the proposed off-street parking facilities remains available. This broken yellow line extends an existing but unidentified 37 metres of broken yellow line by 22 metres.

(n) No Stopping At All Times – Mortimer Terrace – Brooklyn (69-09)

According to aerial photographs of Mortimer Terrace there are extensive areas of broken yellow lines painted largely to reinforce the requirements of the Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004 that prohibits parking on corners, bends within the areas of intersections and so on but have not been ratified. Mortimer Terrace is too narrow, typically less than 5 metres wide, for parking to take place on both sides of the road.

This proposal is intended to ratify this restriction to remind drivers of their legal obligations and to ensure reasonable, uninhibited access is always available to all road users.

(o) No Stopping At All Times – Parkvale Road – Karori (71-09)

Anomalies in the application of broken yellow lines at the intersection of Parkvale Road with Friend Street and Samuel Parnell Road have been brought to our attention by a local resident. This report recommends minor changes to ratify parking restrictions that will enable the intersection to function safely while maximising parking for local residents. The recommended deletion of a broken yellow line leaves an earlier, shorter and adequate length of broken yellow line to ensure sight lines and manoeuvrability remain adequate.

(p) Time Restricted Parking – Arawa Road – Hataitai (72-09)

The Council has received a request from the public and a correspondence from the Principal at Hataitai School advising that there are currently no short-stay parking spaces available near the school to drop off and pick up pupils. A site visit confirmed that Arawa and Hohiria Roads are being used for all day parking. It is proposed to establish five P5 parking spaces along Arawa Road for half an hour in the morning and afternoon during the school terms so that parents can drop off and pick up their children safely from the school.

(q) Bus Stop, At All Times – Adelaide Road – Mount Cook (74-09)

The Royal New Zealand Foundation for the Blind (RNZFB) has requested the relocation of the existing bus stop situated adjacent to two driveways. The lack of a well defined waiting area and numerous vehicle movements across the driveways and footpath have raised concerns and potential hazards for visually impaired bus patrons using this bus stop.

It is proposed to relocate the bus stop 50 metres south from the existing bus stop towards a signalised pedestrian facility. This is considered safer for all bus patrons in a clearly defined waiting area away from the driveways and vehicle movements.

(r) Mobility Parking – Reef Street – Island Bay (75-09)

Currently, there are no mobility parks near Shorland Park. It is proposed to convert the regular parks into two mobility parks. This will provide access to the

park facility and the nearby local services adjacent to The Esplanade for mobility users.

The mobility parking policy aims to ensure Wellington is a liveable place for people with limited mobility by enhancing their ability to participate in social, cultural and political life and their access to services and resources.

(s) No Stopping At All Times, Time Restricted Parking – Upland Road – Kelburn (78-09)

A local resident is frequently disadvantaged by vehicles overhanging an open parking space too short for three cars but too long for two vehicles. A history of obstruction complaints has ensued. The purpose of this recommendation is to provide individual parking spaces for two cars reinforced by a short broken yellow line abutting the resident's driveway. This will more effectively remind drivers of their legal responsibility, improve access and alleviate the need for the resident to request enforcement.

(t) Time Restricted Parking – Hankey Street – Te Aro (79-09)

The Hankey Street Dairy has had the benefit of a 10 minute parking restriction for over ten years. The incidence of vehicles overstaying this limit is growing to the detriment of this business and a history of infringements has developed. This business owner has requested the time limit be halved. Shortening the time limit to five minutes may remind drivers that their visits are indeed short leaving insufficient time for associated business and will simplify regular enforcement as and when required.

(u) Revised Restrictions Between John and Mein Streets – Riddiford Street – Newtown (80-09)

As a consequence of the improvements to Riddiford Street outside the new Wellington Regional Hospital there are a number of parking changes required. These changes are a result of the road widening improvements and the introduction and relocation of traffic signals in the area. These changes reflect rationalisation of bus stops and general parking south of John Street to opposite the main entrance to the Hospital. These changes follow others made during the project and implemented earlier in the year but better reflect how the local businesses in the area want to see the parking managed now the project is completed.

(v) Time Restricted Parking – Rintoul Street – Newtown (81-09)

Council has received a request from a dairy owner to change the P15 outside the shop to P15, Monday to Sunday 8:00am - 8:30pm, as this business opens seven days a week, day and night. Changing the restriction would greatly help this dairy to serve the community.

4. Conclusion

This report recommends amendments to the Wellington City Council's Traffic Restrictions for Council's approval.
