## 3. Discussion

#### Background

The 2010/11 Draft Annual Plan represents year two of the 2009-19 LTCCP. The development of the Draft Annual Plan has been guided by the principles outlined as part of the LTCCP that aim to balance continued investment in the city while maintaining a wide breadth of quality services that are value for money.

Planning for the 2010/11 Draft Annual Plan started in late 2009 and included identification of variances to the LTCCP following a review of the year two work programme.

The proposed variances (outlined in the appendices) were identified to deliver on key areas of focus for 2010/11 including: delivering on the commitments for year two; leveraging off the Rugby World Cup to showcase Wellington to the world; ensuring capacity for the future; and aiming for zero harm.

The proposed variances were considered at a Councillor workshop in December 2009 and in February 2010, and include variances raised by elected members.

The attached schedule of variances reflects the discussions at these workshops, with the exception of the Adelaide Road (appendix z). This was pending at the time of the workshop.

Subject to the deliberations process, all variances will be consulted on with the community during April and May as part of the 2010/11 Draft Annual Plan<sup>1</sup>.

Consultation on the Climate Change Action Plan and the Community Facilities Policy will run concurrently with consultation on the 2010/11 Draft Annual Plan.

## 4. Conclusion

This paper presents proposed variances for year two of the LTCCP and seeks a decision on whether they be included in the 2010/11 Draft Annual Plan statement of proposal for consultation with the community.
