Further to the Tawa Community Grants application on behalf of Rotary Club of Tawa for \$1,500 to replenish the hanging flower baskets in the Tawa Main Street business center later in 2015.

I understand that there may be additional funds available and we wish to take this opportunity to get professional help in reviewing and refurbishing the watering system for the baskets. Over recent months there have been a number of complaints from some of the adjoining shop owners that some of the baskets are not being watered evenly, or the water is being sprayed in an unintended angle over the footpath or the baskets are not being watered at all due to blockages in the distribution outlets. I have been provided with a contact firm of "Total Irrigation" from the WCC Horticulture team who we will approach for this work. We therefore wish to apply for an additional funding of \$500 to cover this work.
