# TRAFFIC RESOLUTIONS

## 1. Purpose of Report

This report outlines the recommended amendments to the Wellington City Council Traffic Restrictions. These recommendations support the achievement of the Council's Transport Strategy Outcomes of safety, accessibility, efficiency and sustainability.

## 2. Recommendations

  - (a) No stopping at all times Bell Street Tawa (88-09)

Northwest side, commencing 10 metres northwest of its western intersection with Bell Street (Grid Coordinates x=1753967.412874 m, y=5442358.044624 m) and extending in a north-easterly direction following the kerbline for 8 metres.



## 3. Discussion

The following information relates to the amendments before the Committee for approval.

### (a) No stopping at all times - Bell Street – Tawa (88-09)

The Council has received a request to install No Stopping At All Times restriction at its intersection with Mexted Terrace. Cars parked on this corner obstruct driver visibility of turning traffic in this area.

### (b) Mobility parking - Hinau Street – Tawa (89-09)

Council has received a request from the Linden Surgery Centre to install an onstreet mobility park. Presently, short term parking is available but often filled to capacity. This makes it difficult for mobility patients to find nearby parking. The centre has requested this mobility park to better serve their patients needs.

### (c) No stopping at all times - Mexted Terrace – Tawa (87-09)

The Council has received a request to install No Stopping At All Times restriction at its intersection with Bell Street. Cars parked on this corner obstruct driver visibility of turning traffic in this area.
