Description:	This is a 79.123ha reserve that extends from Grenada North to Horokiwi. This land was vested in the Council in 2000 (ex-Transpower block). It contains manuka-mahoe dominated forest with advanced regeneration, with some pasture, gorse and tauhinu. In the future, this reserve will be important for forest connectivity including seed distribution.	
Current uses:	A commercial War Games company operates here. There is a dual use track through the reserve to Horokiwi Road (near Belmont Regional Park entrance). Transpower has power pylons on the reserve.	
Future developments	The Northern Reserves Management Plan recommends - a landscape development plan gets prepared. - that recreation activities be contained to areas that have low ecological values.	
Classification recommendations:	Scenic Reserve B , due to the 1) ecological values – advanced regenerating bush, size and future importance in ecological connectivity and 2) landscape values – vegetated backdrop to Grenada North. There are minor recreation and utility values.	

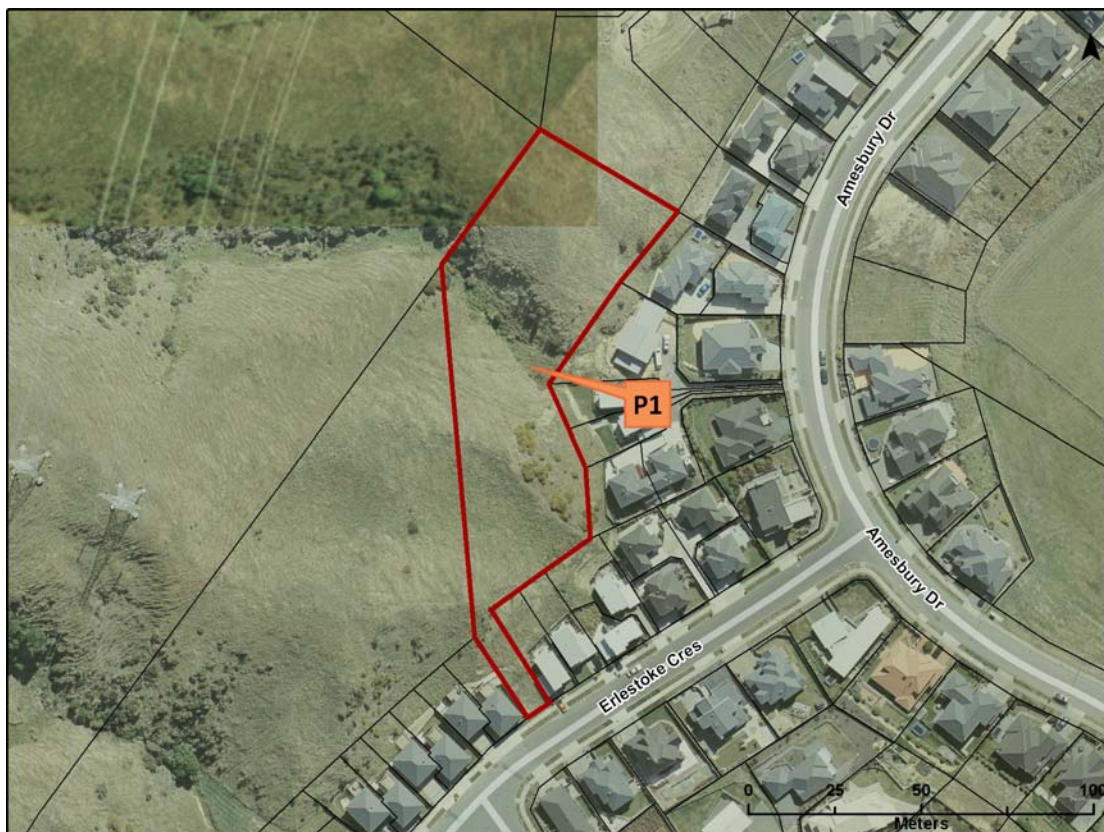

Legal information:	Lot 7 DP 49151 CT WN26B/975	
Description:	This is a 3.1353ha parcel of land between Caribbean Avenue Reserve (Site 2204) and Horokiwi Road. This reserve is near a large block that is leased to Greater Wellington to manage as part of Belmont Regional Park (on other side of Horokiwi Road). Regenerating native shrubland. This land was vested in the Council in 1978.	
Current uses:	The track from Caribbean Avenue to Horokiwi Road goes through this reserve.	
Classification recommendations:	Scenic Reserve B , due to the 1) ecological values – regenerating bush and 2) landscape values – vegetated backdrop to Grenada North (connects to Caribbean Avenue Reserve) and good views of valley including Tawa and Porirua. There are minor recreation values.

Legal information:	Lot 1 DP 80235 CT WN47A/14	
Description:	This 2.1425ha block is a steep face above the Tawa College Sports fields and below the Woodburn Drive subdivision. Gorse dominated scrub with occasional mahoe emerging. This land was vested in the Council in 1996.	
Classification recommendations:	Scenic Reserve B , due to the 1) ecological values – regenerating bush and 2) landscape values – visible from SH1 Motorway, Tawa and Greenacres..

Current uses:	Walking tracks from Ladbrooke Drive to Fernhaven Grove and Bayswater Place	
Classification recommendations:	Scenic Reserve B , due to the 1) ecological values – including forest remnant, size, ecological connectivity and Harbour Escarpment vegetation and 2) landscape values – visible from surrounding houses and component of the escarpment which is visible around Wellington Harbour Minor recreation values
