# **REPORT 8** (1215/12/IM)

## HANGING BASKETS OUTSIDE MAIN ROAD SHOPS

#### 1. Purpose of Report

To provide funding for hanging baskets to be put in place outside the shops on the east side of the Main Road central shopping area.

#### 2. Recommendations

It is recommended that the Tawa Community Board:

- 1. Receive the information.
- 2. Agree to provide funding from the Tawa Community Board Discretionary Fund (CX590) to cover costs incurred by the Tawa Community Board in setting in place a number of hanging baskets outside the Main Road shops, up to a maximum of \$1500.

#### 3. Background

As part of its campaign to enhance the Tawa central shopping area, the Tawa Community Board is promoting the idea of a number of hanging baskets outside the shops on the eastern side of the Main Road between Drummond's Pharmacy and the Mervyn Kemp Library. Discussions have already taken place with many of the shop owners who are generally in favour of the idea.

To kick-start the scheme, the Tawa Community Board will procure a number of hanging baskets (with appropriate contents) and arrange for them to be put in place in the designated area.
