PRIMARY LIAISON PERSONS ON ROADING MATTERS

1. Purpose of Report

Historically, the Tawa Community Board has had an Officer/Member Roading Working Group, the objective of which was to provide community input into the Tawa area's yearly roading, right of way and footpaths programme for the Tawa area.

The Working Group consisted of one Council officer, namely a Traffic Engineer, and two members of the Tawa Community Board.

Last Triennium the Working Group was disestablished and instead the Chair and one Board member of the Tawa Community Board were appointed as the primary liaison persons between the Council and the Board on roading matters.

The primary liaison persons will be consulted on roading matters. The primary liaison persons may act with any other Board member who wishes to be involved. The officers' consultation with the primary liaison persons will inform their reports before they are brought for consideration before the Board as a whole.

2. Recommendations

It is recommended that the Tawa Community Board:

- 1. Receive the information.
- 2. Agree to appoint the Chair and one other Board member or two Board members as the Tawa Community Board's primary liaison persons between the Council and the Board on roading matters.
- 3. Note that the primary liaison persons will be consulted by officers on roading matters and may act with any other Board member who wishes to be involved.
- 4. Note that the officers' consultation with the primary liaison persons will inform their reports before they are brought for consideration before the Board as a whole.

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
