Mayor Prendergast presented the APW Award to Jenny and Jim Stevenson, and gave the following speech.

"In 1987 Jenny Stevenson founded Wellington Performing Arts Centre in a couple of rooms on the top floor of a nondescript commercial building in King St, Newtown.

Jenny thought it would be fun to get into teaching dance and acting after a career as a dancer and choreographer herself.

Her husband Jim was right behind her. They felt it would balance the rigours of family life and the raising of children. Provide some light relief, artistic stimulation and maybe some income. After all, dreams are free!

Little did they know. King St wasn't big enough, so they moved to the upand-coming part of town, Allen St off Courtenay Place. But they had to rent more space as the number of courses and students kept on growing. On the move again, they found the ideal spot in Vivian St, above Café L'Affare. Now they had a whole floor, with large spaces to accommodate the range of community classes that had sprung up alongside the tertiarylevel diplomas they had negotiated with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority.

It was the 90s. The Latin dance craze was sweeping the world and in Wellington it started at Wellington Performing Arts Centre. As did Ceroc and many other popular social dance and theatre forms.

In its first 21 years the Centre hosted scores of community classes, for the benefit of hundreds – possibly thousands – of Wellingtonians. No one was counting – just doing, and enjoying.

The number of tertiary students who passed through the NZQA-approved courses in dance and musical theatre was close to six hundred.

Many went on to professional careers, in New Zealand and overseas, as they graduated from the Centre to Toi Whakaari, the New Zealand Drama School and the New Zealand School of Dance.

Many did not go on to careers in the arts, but that wasn't the whole point. Students emerged from the Centre with skills and attitudes that will stand them in good stead throughout their lives.

They have the satisfaction of knowing they were prepared to follow their dream and push themselves, often to the limit. Having done that once, they know they can do it again, no matter where their lives lead.

Touring productions were taken around the region, one in partnership with the Council – a road safety play Driving You Crazy. The Fringe Festival and Dance Your Socks Off are among many events and festivals to have benefited from the Centre's facilities as a venue and production house.

More than a hundred local arts tutors have been involved on the teaching side. So we can see the scale of activity has been vast, and the energy on both the teaching and student sides quite extraordinary.

Keeping all this together for so long was never easy, but Jim and Jenny rose to the challenge they had, perhaps unwittingly, set themselves. As well as administering and financially underwriting the Centre, they unstintingly supported individual Wellington artists in many different ways.

The Centre came under the wing of Whitireia Polytech in December as a high-energy going concern with a strong focus on carrying the achievements of the first 21 years well into the future.

The Stevensons could step back, no doubt with some relief, knowing their efforts and those of everyone who had contributed – students, staff, teachers – were not in vain.

Wellington Performing Arts Centre has made an indelible mark on our city and community, for which we will be ever grateful to its inspirational founders.
