# SCHEDULE OF PUBLICLY NOTIFIED MEETINGS -JANUARY 2014 TO DECEMBER 2014

### 1. Purpose of Report

This report seeks the Council's approval of the proposed schedule of ordinary meetings for the Council and its committees for the period January to December 2014.

## 2. Executive Summary

The adoption of a meeting schedule allows for reasonable public notice, planning of forward programmes, and for the planning of other commitments around meetings.

### 3. Recommendations

It is recommended that the Council:

- 1. Receive the information.
- 2. Adopt the schedule of meetings for the Council and its committees for the period January 2014 to December 2014 attached as Appendix 1.

## 4. Background

The Council is required to approve a schedule of meetings so that the meetings can be publicly notified in accordance with the requirements set by the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987. A schedule of meetings for 2014 was presented to the Council at its meeting held on 14 November 2013. The Council resolved as follows:

THAT Council:

*3.* Agree that officers prepare an amended meeting schedule for 2014 for agreement by Council at the 19 December 2013 Council meeting.

As requested an amended schedule of Council and Committee meetings for the period January to December 2014 is attached (Appendix 1).

# 5. Discussion

At its meeting on 14 November 2013 Council considered a proposed meeting schedule based on a six week cycle. That cycle included meetings in the months of January and July, both months that have traditionally be kept free of formal meetings. The Council expressed its desire to retain the status quo that is, keep both months free of meetings.

Staff have reworked the schedule which remains loosely based on a six week cycle, with the months of January and July clear of formal meetings. It is anticipated that with the changed committee structure to four subject based committees, the proposed cycle and schedule will have no negative impact on Council's governance and decision making responsibilities.

The following considerations were taken into account during preparation of the schedule:

- Changing the meeting cycle from four to six weeks.
- The draft programme of the Council's consultation and deliberations activities leading into the 2014/15 Annual Plan.
- Ensuring that, where possible, committee meetings are held between 9.15am-12.30pm, 1.00pm 4.00pm and that Council meetings start at 5.30pm. The Environment Committee is the exception commencing at 9.30am.
- Allowing time for resource consent hearings and additional meetings by ad hoc committees, subcommittees and other bodies.

### 5.1 Additional Meetings and Briefings

The aim, through careful scheduling of work programmes, is to reduce the need for additional or reconvened meetings and the rescheduling of meetings. However, given the breadth of the Council's work, from time to time additional or extraordinary meetings may need to be scheduled.

The Audit and Risk Subcommittee will meet quarterly. Once its external members are appointed and their availability confirmed, meeting times will be scheduled.

#### 5.2 Briefings and Workshops

Briefings and workshops will be held on the following basis:

- Committee specific briefings will be held within the six week cycle.
- A Chief Executive briefing will be scheduled prior to each Council meeting.
- Additional briefings and workshops will be scheduled from time to time.

### 5.3 Ad Hoc Committee, Subcommittee and Other Meetings

The aim is to, as much as possible, schedule meetings in the Tuesday to Thursday block. However, there will be occasions when meetings will need to be scheduled on Mondays or Fridays.


# 6. Conclusion
