Vicky McKay

It is my pleasure to present an Absolutely Positively Wellingtonian Award to Radio New Zealand host Vicki McKay, to recognise her extraordinary level-headedness and calmness in the face of an emergency.

Vicki had just settled down behind the mic at the RNZ studios for her regular All Night Programme slot when a 7.8 magnitude quake struck, just moments into her live broadcast.

This was just after midnight on 14 November, and the shake that struck the upper South Island was felt all over the country. It proved fatal in Kaikōura and Mt Lyford, and had a significant impact on the capital.

Vicki very calmly informed listeners that they were indeed experiencing a quake. As shaking and rumbling became audible in the background, she advised listeners to take cover.

In the face of a disaster, it's important we keep our heads, remember the emergency response advice and the preparedness measures we put in place.

Vicky led by example that night.

Listener numbers grew with more and more people seeking a source of up-to-date information they could trust, and Vicki and fellow presenter Susie Ferguson set the tone for many of us.


Vicki's aplomb in continuing to broadcast without hesitation and for staying calm despite extraordinary circumstances garnered a lot of attention. The clip of her All Night broadcast went viral and was picked up by the BBC, Time, the Independent UK and Huffington Post.

This isn't the first time Vicki has been in the radio hot seat during an emergency. She was similarly cool on air during September 11 attacks, the Hillsborough disaster and the first Gulf War. Vicki has been with RNZ since 1985 and has been working the overnight shift since 1995.

This is a chance for us to thank her for her years of service, and to recognise her extraordinary composure on November 14.

Vicki says that she's now tested the microphone to see if it will stretch far enough for her to continue broadcasting from under the desk if she has to. She says: "It does, and I will."
