

Wellington City Council Housing Upgrade Project



Upgrade work common to all sites



- Making homes warmer & healthier (insulation/ventilation)
- Refurbished kitchens and bathrooms
- Internal and external painting
- Improving security and safety systems
- Extensive landscaping improvements
- Earthquake strengthening (where required)









Te Ara Hou, Newtown



- 67 Units in 6 Blocks
- Construction begins late July
- Upgrade completed May 2010
- 3 Phases 2 Blocks at a time
- Construction 16 weeks per Block
- No unit reconfigurations
- Improved outdoor spaces
- Playground upgrade
- Better waste management systems





Hanson Court, Newtown



- 109 Units in 5 buildings
- Construction scheduled Feb 2010
- Phasing yet to be confirmed
- Indicative construction period 18mths
- No unit reconfigurations
- New Community Space





Central Park, CBD/Brooklyn



- Currently 213 Units
- Construction scheduled July 2010
- 4 Phases
- Unit reconfigurations (Brooklyn Rd)
 - 18 x Bedsits
 - 15 x 1 Bedroom Units
 - 16 x 2 Bedroom Units
 - 4 x 3 Bedroom Units
- New precinct-wide Community Space
- Precinct approach to landscaping





Regent Park, Newtown



- A 'new build' project
- Currently 39 Units housing single people
- To be replaced with 29 Family Units
 - 19 x 2 Bedroom Apartments
 - 5 x 3 Bedroom Townhouses
 - 5 x 4 Bedroom Houses
- Construction scheduled November 2010
- Indicative build period 14 months
- Completed in time for 2012 school year





Kotuku, Kilbirnie



- Currently104 Bedsit Units in 4 Blocks
- Construction scheduled July 2011
- Indicative build period 18 months
- 2 Blocks to be reconfigured
 - 6 x 2 Bedrooms
 - 12 x 3 Bedrooms
- 56 x Bedsits remain
- Small community space to be developed
- Accessible Units
 (2 x Bedsits & 2 x 3 Bedrooms)





Newtown Park



- Currently 278 Units in 6 Blocks
- 1 Block to be demolished
- Unit reconfigurations to decrease Bedsit numbers & increase 1, 2 & 3 Bedroom Units
- Construction scheduled October 2011
- Phasing yet to be confirmed
- Indicative build period 34 months
- Solar heating to low-rise Blocks
- Heat recovery to high-rise Blocks
- Reconfigured and enhanced community spaces



Sites currently undergoing design



Marshall Court, Miramar



- Currently 46 Bedsit Units
- To be reconfigured into 21 Units:
 - 4 x 3 Bedroom Units
 - 17 x 2 Bedroom Units
- Small community space to be developed
- Construction currently scheduled for Feb 2014 but may be brought forward to July 2012

Improvements to site safety and Community Room scheduled in 2010

BERKELEY DALLARD FLATS (Nairn St/Brooklyn Rd)

Design work currently underway

Upgrades have commenced on 8 houses

Survey work continues on the rest of the portfolio








