## **Summary of Submissions**

Proposed District Plan Change 72 (Residential Area Review) – additional summary of submission Wellington City District Plan

Clause 7 of the First Schedule, Resource Management Act 1991

Wellington City Council prepared a summary of submissions on proposed District Plan Change 72, and this summary was publicly notified on 2 February 2010. ## Further submissions close at 5pm on Tuesday 6 April 2010.

The process for public participation from this point is as follows:

- if a person making a submission or further submission asks to be heard in support of their submission, a hearing must be held
- the Council will give its decision on the proposed Plan Change (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions)
- anyone who has made a submission or a further submission has the right to appeal the decision to the Environment Court.

Within five working days of making your further submission to Council, you must provide a copy of your submission to any original submitter(s) that you have opposed or supported.
