



Mason's Lane Upgrade

Construction is now underway on the makeover of Mason's Lane. The laneway upgrade is expected to take approximately 12 weeks.

Underway at the same time is the Civic Assurance project removing the canopy covering the lane. This work has started with the canopy totally removed by the end of October.

→ The works

The Mason's Lane upgrade is well underway! We are transforming this important pedestrian link between Lambton Quay and The Terrace to a well-lit and appealing pathway.

An intensive deep-clean of the ceiling, walls and steps has been completed, and the mural now removed. With old material removed and the site cleaned up, construction can begin. The living green wall is growing well and currently being prepared for installation.

Work has also commenced taking down the canopy over the lane. This occurs at night to minimise disruption for nearby businesses.

→ Safety and access

Current work includes fixing electrical cables to the ceiling, and attaching timber cladding to the walls. The stairwell has been scaffolded to reach these areas, meaning you'll need to use either Farmers Lane or Bowen Street to move between the Terrace and Lambton Quay.
