


Where you can place signage

Signage can be up to 3 square metres in area and up to 4 metres in height


Private land/property, with permission from the property owner

Private fencing, with permission from the property/asset owner

Closest possible public land location, if the property has zero street visibility

Prior approval from Council is needed in this instance. Email a diagram of your requested location to streetactivities@wcc.govt.nz




Public land or public road corridor

open-home-style signs 




