Minute #5 of Independent Hearing Panel

The purpose of this Minute is to inform the parties of the closure of the hearing.

1. Hearing

The hearing to consider the above application and the submissions received was held on Wednesday and Thursday 1 and 2 May 2024, in the Tory Room, Urban Hub, Level 2-4, 318 Lambton Quay, Wellington City. The hearing was adjourned at 6pm following the oral reply from the applicant.

The applicant was given leave to prepare a written reply to matters arising during the hearing, including an updated set of recommended resource consent conditions. The applicant's written reply was circulated on Monday 13 May 2024.

2. Closure of the Hearing

The Hearing Panel has subsequently reviewed all of the evidence and other information before us and have determined that we have sufficient information to make a decision. Accordingly, we have formally closed the Hearing today, Thursday 16 May 2024.

The Panel's decision on the resource consent application will be released and circulated within 15 working days (which excludes public holidays such as King's Birthday on 3 June 2024): that is, by close of business on Friday 7 June 2024.
