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#### 2. General Business

#### 2015-25 DRAFT LONG-TERM PLAN HEARINGS REPORT

#### **Purpose**

1. The purpose of this report is to provide Council with context around the formal consultation process, submissions received and a list of submitters who have indicated they wish to speak in support of their submission to the Draft Long-term Plan (LTP) 2015/25.

#### Recommendations

That the Governance, Finance and Planning Committee:

Receive the information.

#### Discussion

- Wellington City Council undertook public consultation on its draft LTP 2015/25 from 13
   March to 24 April 2015. In addition to the formal consultation process, Council also had
   a dedicated and newly designed webpage displaying and discussing all key LTP
   issues.
- 3. Interactions with residents and ratepayers resulted in a total of 1,012 formal submissions during the consultation period. Slightly less than 7,000 individual topical comments were received.
- 4. The LTP webpage had 12,872 visits from 7,568 people and 2,191 informal comments and pieces of feedback were received.
- 5. The five major issues that were formally submitted on are:
  - Cycling
  - Living Wage
  - Airport Extension
  - Passenger (Public) Transport Network
  - Council's Growth Agenda
- 6. A concurrent consultation on the Draft Wellington Waterfront Development Plan was conducted from 20 March to 24 April 2015.
- 7. A total of 236 submissions on the Draft Wellington Waterfront Development Plan were received at close of business on Friday 24 April 2015.
- 8. Oral hearings will be held from 5 May to 8 May as well as 12 May 2015, for both the LTP 2015/25 and the Draft Wellington Waterfront Development Plan.
