It was noted that a request for public participation from Felicity Wong, on behalf of Historic Places Wellington, to speak regarding Item 2.3, Decision on objections to the proposed road stopping and disposal of legal road land adjoining 400 Middleton Road, Glenside, was declined under Standing Order 2.23.3(d) as the public participation relates to a matter that is subject to a statutory hearing process currently before the Council.
