 - b. Agree to dispose of the Land.
 - c.  - b. The leased area will be 523 sqm (approx) and will include the community room, the clubroom and storage rooms. (see attached plan Attachment "1")
 - c. Notes that the lease will be executed following completion of refurbishment works to create the community and sports hub facilities and provided the Society has made the requisite payments and is not in breach of any provision in the Partnering Agreement between the Council and the Society
- 3. Notes that approval to grant the lease on reserve land is conditional on:
 - a. Appropriate iwi consultation
 - b. Public notification as required under sections 119 and 120 of the Reserves Act 1977
 - c. No sustained objections resulting from the above notification
 - d. Legal and advertising costs being met by the Lessees (where applicable)
