# 1. 4 Public Participation

### 1.4.1 Feedback on the Community Plan

Feedback on the Community Plan was presented by the Chair, and two members of the Makara community, Rick Marshall and Kim Gray, were present for the discussion. The issues of preserving pockets of native forest and weed and pest control were common in the feedback. Roading was also raised, including having more passing bays. It was asked that South Karori be specifically mentioned in the plan, as it is part of the Makara/Ohariu Community Board's area. An idea to preserve the personal history of locals who live in Makara and Ohariu via recordings received support, and could provide content for the potential Makara/Ohariu website. This led to a wider discussion on having members of the community provide content for the website, and how the projects in the Community Plan could feed into that.

### 2.1 Roading

The Board discussed new work being done in the area, including a retaining wall being built in the Takarau Gorge and resealing on parts of Takarau Gorge Road and Ohariu Valley Road. The Chair will follow up on the following: whether the Takarau Gorge work requires road closures; transport signs and a bus shelter request for Ohariu Valley; and the melting of the road in hot temperatures at parts of Ohariu Valley Road. The Chair will also check progress regarding the trimming of broome at the top of Ohariu Valley.
