This report outlines recommended amendments to the Wellington City Council Traffic Restrictions. These recommendations support the achievement of the Council's Transport Strategy Outcomes of safety, accessibility, efficiency and sustainability.

3. Discussion

The following information relates to the amendments before the Community Board for approval.

(a) Mobility Parking – Main Road – Tawa (40-09)

A mobility park has been requested by the co-ordinators of the Christadelphians Tawa Ecclesia to facilitate access for their mobility members. Due to the high parking demand during services or events, the mobility members often have to park a considerable distance from the church. This report proposes that a mobility park be installed to ensure safe parking access.

(b) Mobility Parking – Hinau Street – Tawa (41-09)

Council has received a request from the Linden Surgery Centre to install an onstreet mobility park. The current off-street parking provided by the centre is at a lower ground level which is inaccessible for mobility users due to the steepness of the road. In addition, on-street parking is available but often filled to capacity. These make it difficult for mobility patients to find nearby parking. The centre has requested this mobility park to better serve their patients needs.

(c) No Stopping At All Times – Mexted Terrace - Tawa (46-09)

The Council has received a request to install No Stopping At All Times restriction at its intersection with Bell Street. Cars parked at this corner currently obstruct driver visibility in this area.

(d) Time Restricted, P120 – Cambridge Street – Tawa (48-09)

The Council has received a request from Tawa Community Board to change the time limited parking P15 and the unlimited parking in front of Tawa Community Centre on Cambridge Street to P120, including the mobility parking which applies at all times. The existing restriction is no longer relevant due to the change of activities within the Centre.
