Dear Charles

Many thanks for sending through the information today regarding potential speed bumps around the residential area of Willowbank Road.

I have great concerns regarding the speeding of cars along my road epically outside my drive. I have young children, which I need to deliver to school by car and it is extremely dangerous getting out my drive. This is something that the neighbours experience also.

Willowbank Road on the North end of it, has a group of approximately 14 houses, to house # 27, and then becomes quite a rural road. It is a surprising rural road within the city. It was once a 100km zone, which is now dropped to 70 Km. It is a well know sped track to "hoons" and grannies alike. Along the line of houses prior however is a 50km zone. (i.e. in front of my house #25). However cars heading south, come down the hill, and along the road and seeing the rural look of the road they just put their foot down and take off. The 70km sign is around the corner a ways, cars have speed up considerably before the sign however. Coming down the hill cars just naturally speed up. By the time they get level to my house, they are going full noise.


I did see the rubber lines laid over the road before Christmas, I presume by the Council, checking speed and such. They must have been about level with house number 12 or 14. Had they been laid at the level of house #27, which is the last house in this segment I suspect the speed recorded would be even higher.

From my own observations in the mornings cars peel off the motorway, more so when the motorway is congested, and speed down Willowbank Road to go up Worcester Road to the on ramp at Grenada South, to hop the motorway queue. As the purpose of it is to jump motorway traffic they are going as fast as they can go.

It is not just the morning traffic that is speeding and problematic, it is at any point during the day and night.

On looking at our signed perdition for speed bumps, you may think it does not appear to be a lot of names. However what it does represent is a member of each house affected along this Northern part of Willowbank Road. We are all in unity on the wish to see improvement and safety to our community.
