# RE-APPOINTMENT TO COUNCIL CONTROLLED ORGANISATION

# 1. Purpose of Report

This report seeks approval for the re-appointment of a Council representative to the board of Positively Wellington Venues (Wellington Venues Ltd).

# 2. Executive Summary
