Comments

We wife and I have serious concerns about the quarry expansion for multiple reasons: - It will not be possible for the quarry to contain dust impacts within their boundary (our property is already coated inside and out with a fine brown dust). - It will be a massive eyesore to all visitors to Wellington coming down Ngauranga Gorge on SH1, and the proposed plans to build a small fence and paint that will do nothing to prevent everyone from seeing what's really going on behind it We have accepted the impacts of the current quarry as the original intent was for the current quarry to be quarried for a 30 year period (though this has already run over) and then was going to be mediated and allowed to grow over. That hasn't happened, and I can guarantee that the current plan change 83 will also not be mediated as planned within 30 years, instead it will be extended just as the current quarry has been, becoming more of an eyesore all the while. Given the council has approved new housing in and around this area, as well as in Newlands overlooking the gorge, I find it surprising that this would be considered.

I seek the following decision from Council (please give precise details)
