- ∉ there will be an opportunity to make a further submission in support of, or in opposition to the submissions; and

- ∉ the Council will give its decision on the Private Plan Change request (including its reasons for accepting or rejecting submissions); and
- ∉ any person who has made a submission has the right to appeal the decision to the Environment Court.
