Stream 1 and 2 Procedural Matters

Stream 1

1. The Council has requested more time for its Reply. A number of the Hearing Panel are involved in other hearings and thus provision of extra time for the Council's reply will not prejudice the Hearing Panel's deliberations.
2. Accordingly, we enlarge the time for preparation of the Council's reply by two weeks (to 30 March).

Stream 2

3. The Hearing Panel has undertaken a preliminary review of submitter evidence. It believes it would be assisted if the urban design expert for Kāinga Ora, Mr Rae, were to caucus with the Council's urban design expert, Dr Zamani.
4. They are requested to provide a Joint Witness Statement not later than 1pm this coming Monday 27 March, in order that it might be in hand for the commencement of the hearing.
5. It is appreciated that they may not have had time to caucus on all relevant issues by then, but the Hearing Panel would request that they provide a Joint Witness Statement on any matters they are able to cover and we will consider whether to make further directions for caucusing on remaining issues when the hearing commences.
