These are additional matters that there was not time to discuss fully at the hearing.

In response to the s42A amendments report of 13 May 2022 Living Streets Aotearoa seeks the following relief:

INF S12 Design of Streets

Please remove reference to 1 metre pedestrian paths – these are too narrow for all pedestrians. Either make the minimum width 1.8 metres or include a pedestrian way on the driveway. Providing a different surface material is one way to permit and distinguish a pedestrian path from the vehicle path.

Local Street M4 with 3000 annual average vehicles per day

Please remove the reference to Cuba Mall from the list, it has its own legislation as a pedestrian-only area.

Please include limited public notification of near neighbours for TR3 and TR4 driveways. Neighbours often have the solution to pedestrian and vehicle access on narrow or below-standard accessways.

Please amend the definition of pedestrian as follows:

Pedestrian means a person on-foot ~~walking rather than travelling in a vehicle~~, including a person with impaired mobility who relies on mobility assistance including a wheelchair.

TR S3 1d Pedestrian and cycle conflict

Please amend as follows

Cycling and Micromobility parking facilities must be located:

- i. So they are easily accessible for users, within 20m of the primary entrance;
- ii. So they do not impede pedestrian footpaths and thoroughfares including areas used by people whose mobility or vision is restricted;
- iii. To be clear of vehicle parking or manoeuvring areas; and
