- Submitters will have approximately **10-15 minutes** to speak to their submission and answer any questions from the Hearing Panel. This excludes submitters who have gained leave from the Chair for a longer presentation. This must be requested through the Hearing Co-ordinator by **1pm Tuesday 29 August 2023.**
- The Hearing Panel will have read all submissions, evidence, and pre-circulated documents. Your presentation should focus on the key points of your submission.
- Please ensure you are present at the hearings venue or have joined the Microsoft Teams meeting at least 20 minutes before you are due to speak.
- If you require a translator (NZ sign or te reo Māori) please notify the Hearing Co-ordinator at least 10 working days prior to the hearing.
- If you have an electronic presentation over 3 A4 pages, please email this to <u>Jaskirat.kaur@wcc.govt.nz</u> by 1pm Friday 15 September 2023. Please email any presentations less than 3 A4 pages at least 1 working day before the hearing commences.
